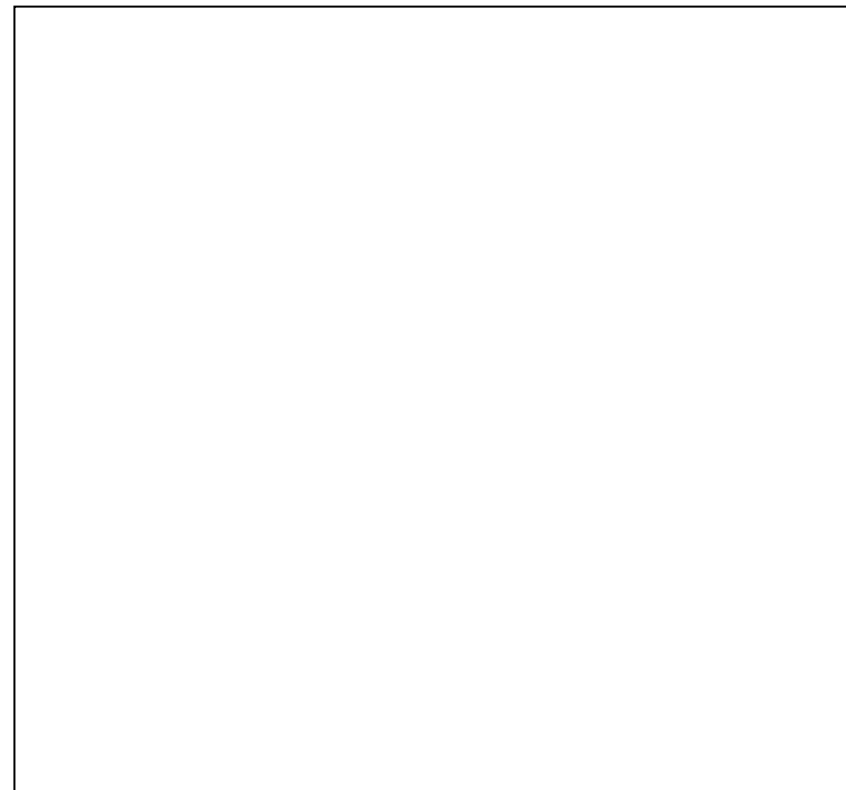
The aim of the project is to develop the children's' imagination skills and their interest and enjoyment of writing.

Name

Numeracy

Our numeracy lessons are covering 5's, 10's and 2 x tables and corresponding division facts. We will be using money in real life situations. We will be using vocabulary related to mass, time, capacity and 2D shape.

Learning Outcome: I will be able to compare, order, read and write 2-digit and 3-digit numbers.

I will be to solve problems involving, numbers, money or measures, using addition, subtraction, multiplication or division.

I will be able to measure and compare lengths, weights and capacities using standard units.

Literacy

Through our theme Traditional Stories we are developing our reading and writing skills. We are continuing to practice reading and spelling the high frequency words as well as revising our letters and sounds knowledge.

Learning Outcome: I will be able to use a familiar setting from a traditional tale and use this as a story plan to write my own story.

Science

We are sorting and naming materials in Science and looking at changes when heating and cooling. We will be learning how pushes and pulls can be used to make familiar objects speed up, slow down or change direction or shape.

Learning Outcome: I will be able to make predictions, test them in a fair way and record my observations using simple tables.

Geography

Through the Katie Morag stories we shall be comparing Scottish island life with life in Drifffield.

Learning Outcome: I will be able to recognise the similarities and differences between my local area and a contrasting place,

History

We will be learning about the Fire of London from the diaries of Samuel Pepys.

Learning Outcome: I will be able to understand what information Pepys diary provides about the Great Fire, why it spread and how London changed afterwards.

R.E.

We are thinking about what it is like to be a leader and as we come towards Easter our work will be about beginnings and endings.

Learning Outcome: I will know the religious significance of Easter.

Art

We will be exploring shapes and patterns in buildings.

Learning Outcome: I will be able to make drawings and develop my pattern and print making skills.
