Dear Parents,

On Tuesday 12th May the Foundation children will be visiting Playdale Farm Scarborough as part of our work on farms. We will be at the farm all day. There will be a health and safety talk before the children visit the animals. The farm also has indoor and outdoor play areas. Please note any allergies on the attached form. The cost of the visit will be £10 which includes the cost of the coach, the entrance to Playdale, an ice lolly and 50 pence to spend in the shop.

The 49 seater coach fitted with seat belts and hired from Phoenix Travel will leave school at 9.15 a.m. and return at approximately 3 p.m. We would be grateful if the £10.00 for the cost of the visit could be paid by Friday 24th April.

There will be 34 Reception children taking part accompanied by 9 adults comprising of 5 members of staff and 4 volunteers - 4 children to 1 adult. As in all school activities the children should respect the authority of all the adult helpers and be prepared to do as they are told.

The children will need a packed lunch with plenty of drink (not fizzy) in a plastic container/flask packed in a bag or rucksack, school sweatshirt, sensible footwear, waterproof coat and a sun hat. If you would like your child to wear sun protection cream please apply before coming to school.

The trip has the approval of the full governing body and is covered by the ERYC Voyager Personal Accident Insurance Scheme. The staff will carry a mobile phone at all times.

If your child suffers from travel sickness or has any specific medical needs please let us know so that appropriate arrangements can be made.

Please complete the parental consent form and return to school with the payment by Friday 24th April at the latest.
