Dear Parents,

On Tuesday 23rd June the Y1 children will be visiting the Hull Street Life Museum as part of our Science and History topics on forces and transport. We will be walking around the museum looking at the development of different forms of transport.

A 49 seater coach fitted with seat belts and hired from Phoenix Travel will leave school at 9.15 a.m. and return at approximately 3.15 p.m. Please would you wait to collect your child at the usual place as due to safety reasons the children will need to leave through the usual exit.

The cost of the trip will be £7.75 per child.

There will be 29 Y1 children taking part accompanied by approximately 8 school members of staff. As in all school activities the children should respect the authority of all the adult helpers and be prepared to do as they are told.

The children will need to wear their school sweatshirt and sensible footwear.

The trip has the approval of the full governing body and is covered by the ERYC Voyager Personal Accident Insurance Scheme. The staff will carry a mobile phone at all times.

If your child suffers from travel sickness or has any specific medical needs please let us know so that appropriate arrangements can be made.

There is a small gift shop in the museum and your child may take some spending money in a named purse - no more than £3 please.

If you wish your child to take part in this trip please complete the parental consent form and return to school with the payment by Thursday 4th June at the latest.
