As part of our learning in Science, about Living things and their habitats we would like to take the Year 2 children on a special trip to the Bempton Cliffs RSPB site and the Living Seas Centre at Flamborough. At the Bempton Cliffs nature reserve trained RSPB staff will introduce the children to the birds that live on the cliffs and the special habitat there. Children will have supervised access to binoculars and telescopes to observe a range of birds in their nests on the cliffs. At the Living Seas centre children will be introduced by trained staff from the Yorkshire Wildlife Trust, to a wide range of creatures that live on the shore.

The trip is booked for the 6<sup>th</sup> June and is in addition to the annual Year 2 trip to Sewerby Hall and Zoo in the summer term.
