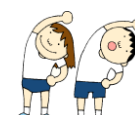
Gardening and Wildlife at Northfield for next half term

Tuesday 4 th June	Ladybirds

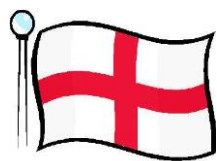


P.E. Kits
