New Starting Times

The new starting and collection times seem to be working well, however, it does appear that we have an increasing number of children arriving late to school, which does impact on individual children's learning. In all our classes teaching and learning starts as soon as the children enter the classroom and arriving even a few minutes late means that children are missing out on important teaching time. It is also important that children are entering the classroom at the same time as all the others because this can often impact on children's emotional wellbeing, making them feel different from the rest of the class. Irregular and late school attendance is monitored and under the Local Authority attendance policy this can lead to a fixed penalty of up to £1000 being issued to parents and carers. Please ensure your child is on the school premises by the time their class enters school everyday. Thank you.
